Motion made by Greg MacPherson: Be it resolved that the directors for the Medicine Hat Catholic Schools' Education Foundation authorize the transfer of \$363.00 related to the unspent funds from the 2016 - 2017 Brown Bag Lunch Program grant to unrestricted net assets.
