Game Rules

Wing n' String (4 Man Best Ball Format)

Each team is allotted 18 yards of string for use as decided.

This string may then be used during play to improve a player's lie or even void a stroke. At any point, a player may move the ball the length of the string or less, to any desired position. If the player uses less than the full length, they have to cut the amount used off. They then have only the remaining amount to use for a future situation in the round. Before the team putts they need to decide if the string will be used for that putt. Extend a shot from the sand trap the same way. One Wing per team (Throw of the ball)

- Men tee off from blue tee markers.
- Ladies tee from white tee markers.
- All players tee off on each hole. The best positioned ball is selected and the other three balls are then picked up. All players hit from the selected position and the system continues until the ball is holed out.
- Each team must use a minimum of two tee shots from each team member.
- The person whose ball is selected need not hit first.
- Ball can be played in any order and can be placed within one club length on the fairway or the rough. If the ball is played in the rough, it cannot be moved to the fairway.
- If the ball selected for play is in a hazard, all shots must be played from the hazard.
- If the ball you choose is behind a tree, you are allowed a two club length relief no closer to the hole. If you choose a ball in a sand trap, the sand may be raked between shots.

Team Captain: He/she will make the final decision on which ball to use, be responsible for the proper use of Wing n' String/ mulligan/hand wedge, fill the scorecards out properly and ensure that the <u>scorecard is totaled and returned to an Organizing Committee Member in the clubhouse</u> as soon as round is completed.

Hole in One Rules -

- Tee from **BLACKS** only (unless otherwise indicated).
- First in cup on the designated Hole In One is the winner.
- Golf pros and under 18 are not eligible for Hole In One awards.
- Wing n' String / Mulligans & Hand Wedges may not be used to win Hole In One.
- Winners scorecard must be signed by an appointed hole spotter and all members of the foursome.
- Minimum 3 players per team required.
