# Medicine Hat Catholic Schools' Education Foundation Grant Submission Process and Guidelines

### Grant Submissions:

- Schools are welcome to submit a grant proposal that outlines how the Education Foundation could be involved in their event or project.
- Grant proposals will be reviewed semi-annually at a scheduled Grant Award Sub-Committee meeting held in October and March of each school year. A date for all scheduled Foundation Grant Sub-Committee meetings and deadlines will be forwarded to school administrators at the beginning of each school year. Grant applications should be submitted in a timely manner to coincide with scheduled Sub-Committee meetings.
  - Information will be forwarded to school administrators in early September to advice schools that the first set of grant submissions are <u>due by September 30th</u>.
  - Sub-Committee will meet early in October to review grant requests. Schools will be notified of the status of their submission **by October 15th**.
  - Subsequently, the second set of grants submissions are <u>due by February 28<sup>th</sup></u> and notifications regarding Grant Award Sub-Committee decisions will be forwarded by <u>March 15<sup>th</sup></u>.
  - The Outdoor Education Grant submissions that are available to Catholic Schools are due <u>by</u> <u>February 28<sup>th</sup></u>.

### Criteria for awarding grants:

- The opportunity must demonstrate that it will develop Catholic Christian Leadership for students, professional staff, support staff and volunteers within the Medicine Hat Catholic Board of Education.
- The opportunity must be in alignment with mission and vision of Medicine Hat Catholic Board of Education.
- The project/event must be in alignment with the values of principals of our Catholic faith.
- Approved Grant Recipients must demonstrate a willingness to provide a presentation and feedback to the Education Foundation.

## Types of expenditures that the Grant Award Sub-Committee <u>may not support</u> include:

- substitute teachers
- international travel
- purchase of capital equipment (computers, furniture, etc.)
- uniforms or equipment for sports teams
- scholarships

<u>**Outdoor Education Grant**</u> available annually to Medicine Hat Catholic Schools to fund student participation in Outdoor Education programs for example: accommodations and rental cost for Camp McCoy/Rattlesnake/Golden Sheaf Park etc.

#### School Project Enhancement Grant Submission:

- Each year the Catholic Education Foundation may award a grant to a district school up to a maximum of \$5,000.00, to enhance school programs/projects/initiatives which may fall within one or more of the funding priorities and are not funded by Alberta Education.
- School Project Enhancements Grant forms will be emailed to schools at the beginning of April.
- The Grant Award Sub-Committee will accept applications until <u>April 30<sup>th</sup></u> of each year and grant announcements will be made directly to school principal by <u>May 31<sup>st</sup></u>.
